From the Water Department ...

Stop the Leaks!

If your water bill seems high, *check immediately* for leaks in your system before calling the city offices. A dripping faucet or other unsuspected leaks may be the cause of a high bill. Water wasted at only 40 pounds pressure through the following size holes amounts to:



- A 1/32" leak wastes 170 gallons in 24 hrs (possible dripping faucet)
- 1/16" leak wastes 970 gallons in 24 hrs (possible leaking toilet)
- A 1/8" leak wastes 3600 gallons in 24hrs (possible leaking soft water unit)
