>>> ANIMALS

Household pets: Large (3) per 1/4 acre property Small (6) per 1/4 acre property

Any animal on or off the premises of the owner, which is not penned, confined, or under the direct control of the owner or a member of his/her immediate family either by leash, cord, chain, or direct immediate communication and present physical control by the owner is considered running at large.

Farm animals: (Per 1/4 acre dedicated

Horse/Cow/Ox (1)

Sheep/Goats (5)

Small animals (25) Small animals include but are not limited to poultry, ducks,

All animals must be properly cared for and the property which is dedicated to their care must meet proper hygiene requirements. Any such animals must be maintained in an enclosure appropriate to the animal and maintained in the side or back portions of lots.

It shall be unlawful for any person to own, keep or harbor any animal which by loud, continued or frequent noise (including but not limited to barking, howling, yelping, crowing, meowing, screeching or other animal sounds), or by noxious or offensive odors, shall annoy, disturb, or endanger the health and welfare of any person or neighborhood.

>>> TRASH

Allowing vegetable waste, garbage, litter, filth, or refuse of any nature to accumulate within or upon any private alley, yard, or area except when it is temporarily deposited for immediate removal.

Nuisance is defined to mean any condition or use of premises or of building exteriors which are deleterious or injurious, noxious or unsightly, which includes, but is not limited to, keeping or depositing on or scattering over the premises any of the following:

Lumber, junk, trash, or debris, abandoned, discarded or unused objects or equipment such as automobiles. furniture. stoves. refrigerators, freezers, cans. containers, or other discarded items not currently in use.

Title 4-2-5



Weeds constitute a nuisance when they create a fire hazard, a source of contamination or pollution of the water, air or property, a danger to health, a breeding place or habitation for insects or rodents, are unsightly or deleterious to their surroundings.
